Failed to Submit Seasonal System Start-up Certification by Due Date

Seasonal public water systems are required to submit certification to the state drinking water program that seasonal start up procedures were followed after the system has been shut down for the off-season. The certification form is to be submitted within fourteen days of serving water to the public

After serving water to the public during June 2020, LaMoure County Memorial Park failed to submit the required certification form on time. Because we failed to follow reporting procedures our system has been issued a violation by the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality.

There is nothing you need to do at this time. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

LaMoure County Memorial Park regrets that this lapse in compliance occurred. It is recognized that compliance with drinking water standards is needed to ensure that safe drinking water is provided to all consumers. Steps have been taken to ensure that the start-up certification will be submitted on time in the future.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly. You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
