

**OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE LAMOURE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSONER  
BUDGET MEETING-September 29,2020**

Chairman Keith Heidinger called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with the pledge to the flag. Commissioners Bruce Klein, Marvin Schulz, Bob Flath, and Lee Miller were present. Also attending were Auditor Jan Hamlin, Treasurer Cindy Worrel, Clerk of Court Billi Warcken, and Highway Superintendent Josh Loegering. Patty Wood Bartle with the Edgeley Mail joined the meeting telephonic.

The commissioners went through the budgets. Josh Loegering discussed some Bank of North Dakota loans to do highway paving. Bonding was also discussed for this type of project. Treasurer Cindy Worrel said that the Deputy Auditor/Treasurer was all in the Auditor's budget figures and wanted to make sure the position will be shared by both offices. Yes, the position will be shared. The mill rate for the general fund is at 52.17. There was some discussion about going to the full 60 mills next year for more road projects. The commissioners will ask HR, Tanya Wieler, to look into a 30-year salary schedule instead of the 20-year next year since that is when the salary schedule will have a market review. The commissioners decided to go with the step and 1% COLA for the salaries. They are not proposing any changes from the preliminary budget.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:25 a.m.
