9:05 am. Chairman Jason Gross called the regularly scheduled meeting of the LaMoure County Water District to order.

Gross called for additions or changes to the agenda. Items to be added included addressing the LaMoure/Barnes cancelled meeting and update of the City of Edgeley v. Steffes complaint. Motion by Klug to approve the agenda with additions, seconded by Haugen and passed.

Gross stated that the joint board meeting was cancelled due to meeting notice problems. Most in attendance were here for that meeting. Radermacher and Trosen outlined the status of the joint agreement and the upcoming steps required before any further actions could be taken on that project. A few minutes were spent in public comment and questions regarding the potential impacts on Ransom and Dickey Counties and control/mitigation concerns.
