

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE LAMOURE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER SPECIAL MEETING- August 9, 2022

The Board of LaMoure County Commissioners met Tuesday, August 9, 2022, with Chairman Bruce Klein, Commissioners Bob Flath, and Keith Heidinger, and Auditor Jan Hamlin. Those attending virtually were Commissioners Lee Miller and Jason Weigel. Chairman Klein called the meeting to order at approximately 8:05 a.m. with the pledge to the flag.

Auditor Hamlin went over the totals for the 2023 Preliminary Expenditures. The County General total \$2,605,796, the Special Funds \$4,592,398, and the Trust & Agency Funds \$620,458. Hamlin explained that the State Aid value has been removed from the expenditures since it is already accounted for in a different line item. The Prairie Dog expenditure will be \$2,449,487 only if the funds are distributed to the county. The grand total without Prairie Dog is \$7,818,652 which includes \$785,888 for American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA). This would be a 1.05% increase over last year. Comm Flath made a motion to approve the preliminary budget as presented, seconded by Comm Heidinger. Roll call vote; Comm Miller-yes, Comm Weigel-yes, Comm Flath-yes, Comm Heidinger-yes, and Chairman Klein-yes. All voting aye, motion carried.

The Public Hearing Date has been set for September 20th at 10:00 a.m.

There being no further business, Chairman Klein adjourned the meeting at 8:19 a.m.
